

SPRINGBOARD CHALLENGE PLANNING GRANT Selection Criteria

Proposal Section	Review Criteria
Addresses unmet need in NDD / NID (20 pts)	 Does the applicant address a compelling unmet need in NDD or NID? Is the solution relevant to multiple constituents in NDD or NID (academic, clinical, or commercial)? Does the applicant address an issue from the Forum panels?
Impact (20 pts)	 Does the proposal have sufficient background to evaluate: Scope and impact of proposed solution; The "space" in which solution would operate; Competitive advantage compared to current methods What is the expected impact on patients? Is the proposed solution ambitious? Are the expected rewards high if successful?
Project Plan (20 pts)	 Are the project plan, goals, and solution clearly described? Are the proposed activities appropriate? In line with funding provided?
Implementation (20 pts)	 Does the applicant have a compelling funding narrative? Have follow-on funding sources or partnerships been identified? Does solution describe a public-private partnership?
Team Personnel (20 pts)	 Do team personnel have relevant core competencies? Relevant scientific, clinical, regulatory, or commercial experience Are team members comprised from multiple areas (academia, biopharma, government, patient advocacy, or foundations)? Is at least one team member based in the US or UK? [Awards will be made to a team member in the US or UK.]
Overall Score (20 pts)	What is the overall score of the proposal?
